CODE OF CONDUCT

Introduction

The intention of this document is to establish clear and acceptable behavior expectations for the members of the Pagosa Springs Tennis Club [“PSTC”] and their guests. It is also the intent of the document to ensure that guests and members of Wyndham Resort also are shown the same respect.

It is important that everyone associated with PSTC should, at all times, act with integrity and show respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of others.

Code of Conduct

As a Member of the Pagosa Springs Tennis Club, you are expected to abide by the following club rules. Breaches will result in loss of membership or other disciplinary action.

- Conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike manner and will not knowingly cheat, throw rackets, disrespect Wyndham Tennis Facility employees, guests or members.
- Treat all Wyndham Tennis Facility property and equipment with respect and clean/tidy up after yourselves.
- Bullying behavior will not be tolerated amongst members or guests.
- Refrain from swearing, yelling or other aggressive behavior towards another player, guest or employee of Wyndham Tennis Facility. This behavior will NOT BE TOLERATED.
- Comply with the rules listed on the PSTC signage placed at the Wyndham Tennis Facility; this signage is comprised of rules

regarding time on the court, types of acceptable equipment, banning of alcohol, drugs and smoking, no food or drink, no children under the age of 15 unsupervised, unacceptable usage of courts and ensure entry gate is properly secured.

PSTC has the right to impose the following or other appropriate sanctions on individuals or groups who violate its policy:

- Warning
- Reprimand
- Termination of membership without refund
